All participants will use the hand sanitizer station before entering the SS room. All surfaces including furniture, doors and handles and taps will be sanitized after each program. Bathrooms will be monitored during the program and sprayed when needed Parents/caregivers must spray change tables or pads in bathroom after use Parents/ caregivers must put toys played with in bin provided by facilitator **Entering and Exiting** Families will enter and exit StrongStart one family at time. the StrongStart Hand sanitizer will be at the entrance to all programs for parent use. When program program is held outside, hand sanitizer will be offered Hand sanitizer dispensers will be kept out of the reach of children to avoid accidental ingestion. It is encouraged to bring in only what you need. Parents / caregivers and children must not enter StrongStart if they are ill or have any COVID-19 symptoms Participant/ Signs will be posted to remind everyone of the guidelines protocols and All staff and participants will use hand sanitizer station before entering the Family responsibilities and Centre Safe Practices at All participants will be required to sign an attendance sheet that will act as an **Programs** acknowledgement that they read and agree Any participant that has been asked to leave the premises because of COVID-19 related issues will have to adhere to BFS and SD51 policies before returning to the Family Centre. Adults in the program are expected to respect physical distancing. Participants will enter the school property and Family Centres adhering to physical distancing guidelines, if more than one family arrives at the same time, families will allow 2 meters of space between each other while entering Disposable face masks and gloves will be made available to all participants, though not required for children StrongStart will provide a snack in individual containers or packages. There will be no sharing All coffee/tea service will be served by staff to avoid multi person contact Bathroom will be used by one family at a time. Families are encouraged to use the bathroom at home or elsewhere before arriving at StrongStart All staff and participants are expected to wash hands before leaving their homes for the Family Centres Any participant that uses the bathroom facilities will when possible use paper towels to turn on and off taps, open doors, and will adhere to proper hand washing protocols (information will be posted on bathroom wall) It is everyone's responsibility to respect and honor the BC Health Authorities requirements
