Nut Aware

As you may be know, we have students attending Hutton Elementary School who have severe life-threatening allergies to a number of food items such as peanuts and tree nuts including peanut butter, nut oils, and nut products, eggs and dairy. Touching or ingesting these items may provoke an anaphylaxis reaction which could be fatal in minutes, if not seconds.

For the safety of these children we are continuing with a school-wide education program which includes creating a deeper understanding of anaphylaxis, undergoing EpiPen training, prevention of cross-contamination, proper washing in order to prevent accidental contamination, as well as proper cleaning of a contaminated area.

Keeping all children safe in school is our priority. Recognizing the risks and understanding the steps that can be taken to minimize food anaphylaxis is the responsibility of our entire school community.

Hutton is celebrating Orange Shirt Day this year later this month. We will be do-


